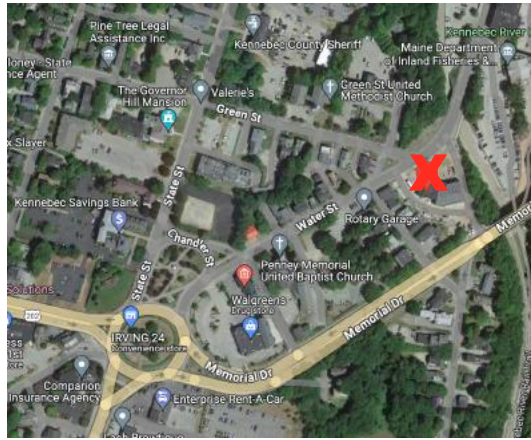
Speakers:
