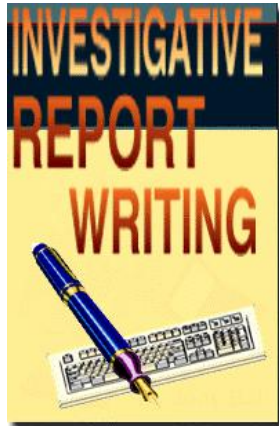

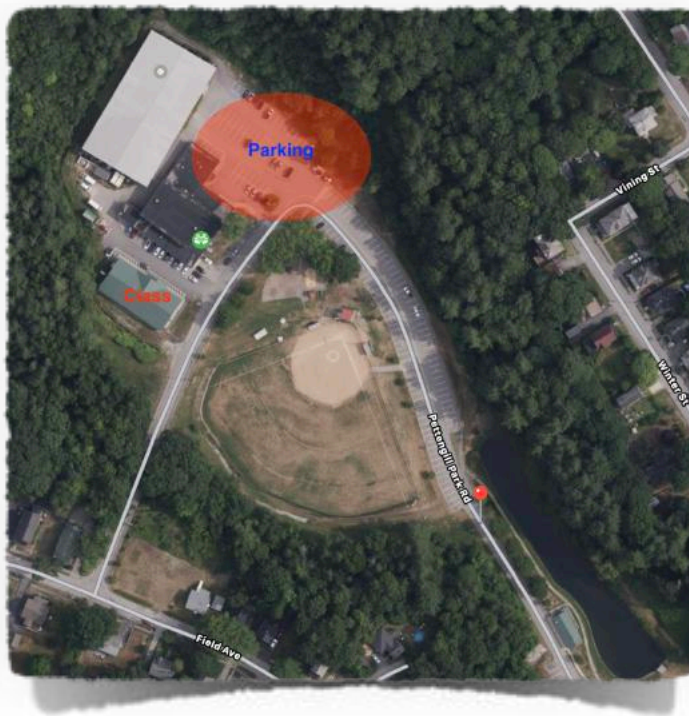
Presenters:
