Welcome to our 17th annual golf tournament. With the assistance of the Poland Spring Golf Course (PGSC), the fees are again being held to last year's prices for the enjoyment of those participating. SCHEDULE FOR THE DAY:

Shotgun start, **(8:30 a.m.)**

Putting contest, (throughout the day)

Beverage carts, (throughout the day) & Box Lunch served on the Course during Golf Awards ceremony, door prizes & raffle (when all the score cards have been passed in)

50/50 - \$1.00 each or 6 for \$5.00 - Tickets available until drawing.

Please note:

Mulligans: \$5 each, limit 8 per Team, 2 per Player. Mulligans cannot be used to win the closest to the pin or longest drive contest.

Putting Contest:

The putting contest is 3 balls for \$5. Mulligans cannot be used on the putting contest. If there is more than one hole in one there will be a shoot out at the end of the tournament. Each participant will get one ball and the closest to the pin wins.

Longest drive: Male, Over 65 & Female

To qualify for the "Longest Drive" the ball must come to rest in the fairway (or on the green if you're really good). Mulligans cannot be used for this contest. **PLEASE LOOK CLOSELY AT THE MARKERS BEFORE PLACING YOUR NAME TO MAKE SURE YOU HAVE THE CORRECT MARKER (Men's White Tees, Ladies Red Tees and 65+ Green Tees Markers)**

Closest to the pin: Male & Female: The hole will be determined by PSGC the day of the tournament.

General:

Be prepared to play golf – **keep up with the pace of the other tournament players.**

Keep team scores. Please replace divots and repair ball marks.

Be respectful of others and HAVE FUN!
